Re: Sanctioning of an Event

Please download an Application for Tournament Sanction form and a Sanction Report form from www.ncrusav.org/ncrjuniors/sanction.asp both located on our website. **Please fill out the application form completely for each date you wish to have an event, if the form is not complete it will delay the process for sanctioning your event!**

To have your event listed on the NCR Junior Tournament Schedule, return the completed application form, by mail to:

or fax: 218-855-1841. **Once approved**, your event will be listed on the schedule. There will be **no** exceptions for this policy!

The report form needs to be returned to the region office with the sanction fee no later than 14 days after the event. Any event directors hosting multiple events can send in their report form and sanction fee after the conclusion of all their events. A reminder for event directors – if you are hosting more than one event, we need an application form filled out for **each** event. Completed sanction forms may be e-mailed to ken@ncrusav.org or mailed to the address listed on the application. **In addition, event directors will be required to provide Sue Murphy with a list of teams along with a copy of the playing schedule for their event at least one week before the event. This list can be faxed or preferably e-mailed to sue@ncrusav.org.**

Please contact the region office when your event is full so that we may mark it on the schedule. Also, we need to know if you cancel your event.

If the above requirements are not met, event directors will be fined \$25 and they may not be able to sanction any additional events with North Country Region! Any event allowing non-USAV teams to participate without NCR approval will be fined \$100!

Sanction fees and all results are due in the region office within 14 days following the tournament unless a different date is agreed upon by the region office and tournament director. Failure to fulfill the above requirements will result in a \$25 fine per date listed on our schedule and future events may not be sanctioned. All sanction fees must be received by June 25, 2010 or there will be an additional fine of \$250!

New for the 2009/10 season! Tournament directors for North Country Region events may allow the libero to serve at their events. There is a space to indicate if you will be doing this on the application form. The libero will not be allowed to serve at Presidents' Day Festival or the Regional/National Qualifier.
