A Message from North Country Region Officials division...

North Country Region is looking to create an "Officials Mission Statement" that would apply to **OFFICIALS, CLINICIANS, TRAINERS, RATERS AND RULES INTERPRETERS** who participate in North Country Region. As we all work together to make this Region stand out in rule application as well as level of play, we are welcoming feedback from our Region Members that will be reviewed when devising the new Officials Mission Statement. If interested in contributing ideas, you may forward your thoughts by June 23rd.

Please KEEP YOUR OUTLINES AND RULEBOOKS FROM LAST SEASON as they are valid for **TWO SEASONS before they will be updated by USA Volleyball again!! USA VOLLEYBALL WILL BE MAKING UPDATES TO RULEBOOKS EVERY TWO YEARS.**

Junior National and National Officials are now required to fulfill 30 hours PER SEASON participating in North Country Region events to keep their certification. This can be done by being a clinician, working at tournaments, etc.

If a junior national/national official is hired to work at a tournament not run by the NCR staff they must bring with, fill out, and submit the hour sheet which can be found on our website. This is mandatory in order to have your hours recorded!

If you have registered for the year, but have not fulfilled your requirements (test, etc.), you will be placed on probation for one year. You will not be able to be assigned to any finals at NCR tournaments. If you don't complete the requirements by the end of the year (August 31st), you will lose your status and be listed as "Not in Good Standing" on the web site. If you don't complete the requirements for the 2nd year, you will lose your status (Provisional or Regional).
